

Guidelines for Use of GBRA Nolte Island Park

The Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) owns and operates the Nolte Island Park and graciously agreed to allow the Texas Lineman's Rodeo Association use of the park. The park is a pristine natural wildlife area and is home to many varieties of wildlife, including turkey, deer, feral hogs, birds, raccoons, skunks, foxes, coyotes, snakes, insects, fire ants, etc. Please be respectful of the land and facilities.

The GBRA has several specific rules that must be followed while on the island:

- 1) All illegal drugs are prohibited.
- 2) All firearms are prohibited, except for law enforcement officers.
- 3) Swimming, Fishing and boating is not allowed in the canal or river.
- 4) Do not cross any barriers that are in place for your safety.
- 5) Powerhouse and substation are restricted areas and are off-limits.
- 6) Cutting of timber is prohibited.
- 7) Open fires are not allowed on the island. Continue to check the website for additional fire prevention instructions. Contained fires will be restricted to the BBQ area.
- 8) All glass containers are prohibited, including bottles.
- 9) Alcoholic beverages are permitted.
- 10) Dispose of all trash and empty containers in the appropriate refuse containers placed around the island.
- 11) Cigar and cigarette butts shall not be thrown on the ground. Dispose of them properly.
- 12) Recycle plastic and aluminum in the recycling containers.
- 13) Each campsite guest will be responsible for cleaning area prior to departure.
- 14) No dumping of septic or wastewater from campers, motor homes, or other means on the island (Restroom facilities are available).
- 15) Portable generators may be used, however, they cannot exceed 70db in noise level. If a complaint is made, the generator must be shut down. The person or utility using the generator is fully responsible for any fuel or oil spill reporting and cleanup.
- 16) Only TLRA authorized motorized vehicles such as golf carts and ATV's will be allowed to be used on Nolte Island.
- 17) NO drones or Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV's) will be allowed to fly on Nolte Island.
- 18) GBRA may limit any activities considered hazardous.
- 19) All campers and rodeo equipment must be removed from the island by 5:00 pm on Sunday, July 17, 2022.
