

Texas Lineman's Hall of Honor

The Texas Lineman's Rodeo Association's Board of Directors is excited to announce that it has approved the creation of a venue in which to recognize the achievements of those who exemplify service to others in the field of electrical power transmission and distribution linework. As Texans, we have the best past, present, and future linemen in the world and their service to our communities, state, nation, and industry has proven time and time again that we are second to none. It is an honor to be able to recognize our brothers and sisters that have given of themselves unselfishly to our industry. The TLRA is about the love of God, Country, Family, and Service to others, and with that we welcome the creation of the Texas Lineman's Hall of Honor to the TLRA family.

The Hall of Honor (HOH) will be hosted in a virtual environment and access will be available through a link on the TLRA.org website. We will be seeking input from those within our industry to provide photos of memorabilia, linemen, tools, and other items of our trade that show the world the importance of what we do to make life happen, comfortably.

The TLRA will solicit nominations for candidates to be considered for induction into the Texas Lineman Hall of Honor. The process of receiving nominations and approving candidates will be done by the TLRA Board of Directors. Nominations will be accepted from March 1st through May 30th each year. The selected inductees will be notified by June 20th and the official induction ceremony will occur at the awards ceremony at the Texas Lineman's Rodeo.

The nomination process will be as follows:

1. Each nomination shall set forth a summary of the nominee's background, including involvement in community and civic groups/organizations, the nominee's electric utility career accomplishments, if applicable, and the nominee's participation or involvement in the Texas Lineman's Rodeo, in any capacity, and his or her overall influence on the success and/or betterment of the Rodeo. Letters in support of the nominee are strongly encouraged.

2. Following the entry deadline, all nominations will be reviewed and considered by the TLRA Board of Directors to select candidates for induction that meet the above mentioned criteria. The TLRA Board will determine the number of nominees to be inducted each year.

Note: Nominees need not be current participants, sponsors, or volunteers but must have contributed to the success or betterment of the Texas Lineman's Rodeo.

3. If a nominee is not selected for induction in the year he or she is first nominated, a nomination may be re-submitted for consideration in subsequent years.

4. The selected candidates will be inducted each year at the Texas Lineman's Rodeo, and they will receive an award in addition to having their names added to the HOH plaque displayed at the Rodeo and on the TLRA website.
